Dean was one of the best customers at the Ladies Basement Sales, acquiring many interesting items for his extensive collection.

Joining us in Worship this morning is Julann Lloyd Dunn. Julann was a member of the 1972-73 Confirmation Class and joined our church on July 3, 1973. While a junior at Westmont Hilltop High School, Julann provided the church with Anniversary Altar Cloths (Paraments) which were dedicated at the 50th Anniversary Worship Service on May 22, 1976. The cloths are needlepoint and were designed and stitched totally by Julann. The presentation was her way of expressing gratitude to the church and praise to Almighty God. Each cloth contains 61,200 stiches and Julann worked on the project for two years.
