

DR. DAN HALE

will be our guest speaker April 28th in the forenoon service, and following in Fellowship Hall with a Q&A Symposium on Congregational Depression awareness.

Dr. Hale is an Assistant Professor at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine's Department of Psychiatry & Behavioral Sciences where he serves as co-Director of the Congregational Depression Awareness Program. He is the co-author of Building Healthy Communities through Medical-Religious Partnerships, published by the Johns Hopkins University Press and now in its third edition (2018), and Healing Bodies and Souls: A Practical Guide for Congregations (Fortress Press, 2003). His most recent book is Depression – Out of the Darkness and into the Light (Gatekeeper Press, 2020). Dr. Hale is the recipient of numerous awards, including the NAMI Metropolitan Baltimore award for the Mental Health Professional of the Year (2016), the Elizabeth Hurlock Beckman Award for Excellence in Education and Inspirational Leadership (2016), and the Maryland Foundation for Psychiatry Anti-Stigma Advocacy Prize (2018).

ON APRIL 28TH, during our Health Sunday service, Edna Nti will be presenting a minute for mission on "Increasing Nutrition Awareness" with a follow-up health fair on May 18th at 10 am.
