MAY MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH



Did you know one in five American adults experience a mental health issue each year? Half of all diagnosable mental health disorders show first signs before a person turns 14 years according to research.

In helping to battle this malaise in our society, the church wide community of Presbyterian Church of USA (PCUSA) has set aside the month of May, each year, to communicate Mental Health Awareness by encouraging educational awareness and understanding of mental health issues and advocacy for mental health services. This is to help eliminate the stigma surrounding mental health, especially serious mental illnesses as well as enable our churches and congregations to be more welcoming, inclusive and supportive faith communities for people living with mental health concerns and their families.

The question is, what can we do as Westmont Presbyterian Church to help provide a safe space and healing to the families of those battling Mental Health? How can we be more welcoming and inclusive as a faith community in taking into consideration the needs of our members and community members battling with this health challenge?

In light of these questions, the preaching in the month of May shall bring awareness to this problem that we are all battling in our community and country. See below the liturgical preaching plan.


